Robert Fox MBE has been a journalist and broadcaster since 1967 and is a Senior Associate Fellow at the Centre for Defence Studies at King's College, London and Defence Correspondent for the Evening Standard. In addition, he commentates on western defence issues for the BBC and Sky News and contributes to *Il Sole 24-Ore*, *Limes*, *the Tablet*, *the Times Literary Supplement* and *the Oldie*.

From 1968-87, Fox was a correspondent and reporter for the BBC covering conflicts in The Falklands, Middle East, Northern Ireland and Italy before joining *The Daily Telegraph* in 1987 as their Defence Correspondent & Chief Foreign Correspondent. At the *Telegraph* his assignments included Afghanistan, the 1991 Gulf War, the Balkans, and the Middle East and the Intifada.

Robert Fox's books include *Eyewitness Falklands* (1982), *I Counted Them All Out* (1982 with *Brian Hanrahan*), *Antarctica and The South Atlantic* (1985), *Camera in Conflict* (1995) and *Liners* (1998). His recent books include *The Story of War* (2002) and the *Iraq Campaign 2003* and he has two further works in progress, *War and Truth: Reporting*
